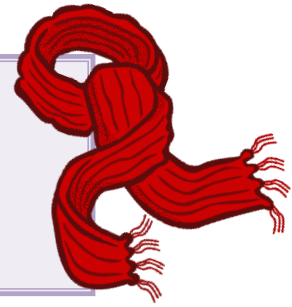

Wishing you all a Very Happy New Year in 2021.


