
Dear Parents

Importance of reading from a young age

- It is important for a child to look at books every day.
- All the family should to be involved in sharing books and children's reading.
- Reading to a child for a short time every day from infancy helps prepare a child to learn. They are never too young!
- During the early years your child is remembering word patterns and learning the language of books.
- Shared enjoyment in reading between a parent and child deepens the child's interest in the world of stories and information and supports them learning to read.
- It promotes and teaches them key literacy skills and promotes early language development.

Healthy Tips

- 1. Before taking your child to the dentist, avoid using phrases such as 'be brave' or 'don't be scared' as this tells your child that there is something to be afraid of! Instead, talk about how the dentist is going to count their teeth and check that they are healthy.
- 2. To find an NHS dentist, please contact NHS 111 (by phone) or <u>www.nhs.uk</u> (via website). Children have free dental treatment until they are 18 years old or 19 years if in fulltime education.
- 3. Expectant women and new mums have free NHS dental treatment until the baby reaches their 1st birthday.
